Appointment of MAPSWS Interim Director

On behalf of the Board of Directors, we are pleased to announce the appointment of Melissa Young as Interim Director of MAP Strategic Workforce Services (MAPSWS) effective September 2019. Melissa will occupy this position for a period of one (1) year during the absence of H el ene Savoie-Louis.

Melissa has had an impressive career as an industry leader and adult educator within the skilled trades. She received a degree in Adult Education from the University of New Brunswick, and has since held several leadership positions in different industries. Melissa was the inaugural Executive Director of a labour management and training organization for 12 years; she then moved into a role with the government of New Brunswick as Liaison Officer with the Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Branch.
